The Louis Stokes Alliance for Minority Participation (LSAMP) aims to increase the quality and quantity of students successfully completing science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) baccalaureate degree programs. The program's goal is to increase the number of students interested in, academically qualified for, and matriculating into programs of graduate study. LSAMP one of the many grants sponsored by the National Science Foundation (NSF).

LSAMP supports sustained and comprehensive approaches that facilitate achievement of the long-term goal of increasing the number of students who earn doctorates in STEM fields, particularly those underrepresented in STEM fields.

LSAMP will sponsor a transition week for incoming first year Virginia Tech students. Students will be eligible to move on campus early, learn about the programs and services on campus, interact with their peers, and learn then necessary skills needed to be a successful STEM student. Students who participate in Transition Week will receive a stipend of \$150 for their participation.
